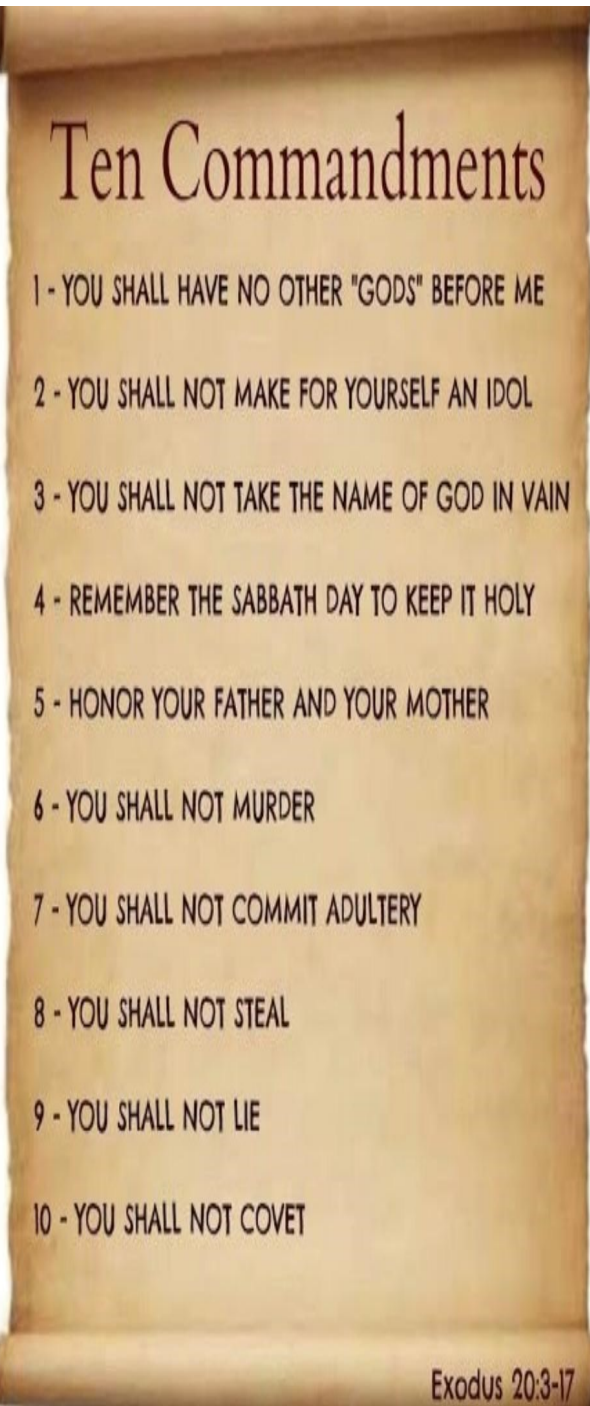

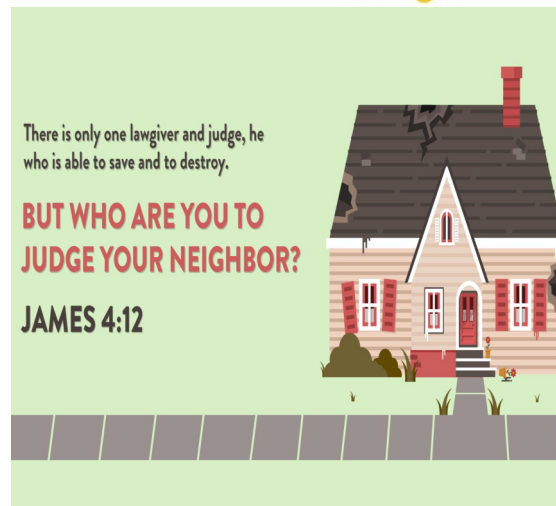
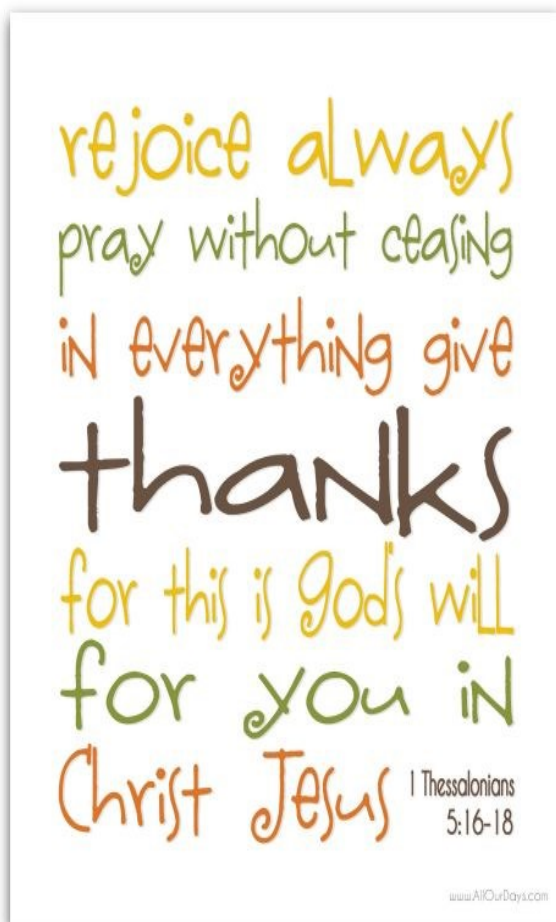

Down to Your Destiny

In **James 4:12**, it says, "There is only one
 Lawgiver and Judge, the one who is able to save
 and destroy. But you—who are you to judge
 your neighbor?" This verse reminds us that God
 alone should judge others. Joseph's life went
 from bad to worse. His brothers betrayed him,
 threw him into a well, and sold him as a slave.
 He was taken to Egypt, where he lost
 everything—his family, name, and status. It
 seemed like he kept going down and down in
 life. Do you feel like you're at your lowest point,
 down to your last hope?

Joseph had one thing left: his destiny. He had
 dreams that showed him God had a plan for his
 life. Even though the details were unclear,
 Joseph believed that God still had a purpose for
 him. Even in chains, he trusted in God's plan.

One More Thought

If Joseph had lost his faith in God, would he
 have risen from slavery to power? Probably not.
 Take a second look at your own dreams. Even if
 life is hard right now, your dreams are still
 possible when you trust in God's destiny for you.
