Cleansing Our Hands and Hearts

"Cleanse your hands and purify your hearts." — James 4:8

Having clean hands and a pure heart shows we are humble. In the Bible, "hands" represent our actions. God uses this idea to tell people to stop doing wrong: "When you spread out your hands in prayer, I will hide my eyes from you; even if you offer many prayers, I will not listen. Your hands are full of blood." (Isaiah 1:15).

During James's time, Jewish priests had to wash their hands before entering God's presence in the tabernacle and temple (Exodus 30:19–21). So clean hands meant being close to God. But cleansing also means purifying our hearts—our thoughts and desires. James 4:8 says, "Purify your hearts."

To be humble and right with God, we must fix our inner selves, which sin affects. The humble person listens to words like Ezekiel's: "Rid yourselves of all the offenses you have committed and get a new heart and a new spirit." (Ezekiel 18:31). Remember what the apostle John promises: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9).
