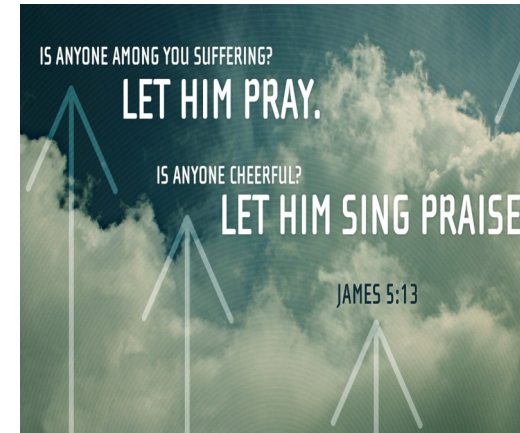

“Let Him Sing Praise”

In **James 5:13**, we are encouraged to sing praise
 when we are cheerful. This reminds us of the
 time when David celebrated the return of the
 Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem. David
 praised God for His goodness and appointed a
 psalm of thanksgiving to be sung by Asaph and
 others before the Ark (**1 Chronicles 16:7**).
 After a difficult time during the period of judges
 and King Saul's failure, Israel could now look
 back on God's many mercies. The psalm calls
 Israel to praise God first (**1 Chronicles 16:13-
 22**), then invites all the earth to recognize God's
 rule over the nations (**1 Chronicles 16:23-31**),
 and finally, even the creation is called to join in
 the praise because of God's kindness to all
 things (**1 Chronicles 16:32-33**).

While the Levites used instruments like harps
 and trumpets to worship in the temple, we, as
 believers, offer spiritual sacrifices from the
 heart (**Hebrews 10:19**). Unlike the Levites, our
 ability to worship comes not from our family
 line, but from being born of the Spirit. Jesus
 warned that external acts of worship mean
 nothing if our hearts are far from God
 (**Matthew 15:7-9**). Therefore, like David's men
 practiced with their instruments, we should
 devote ourselves to spiritual exercises, such as
 prayer and praise.
