

# The Bread, the Cup, and the Church

The Lord's Supper is a special way for Christians to remember Jesus Christ's sacrifice and renew their commitment to Him. In the beginning, God provided food for Adam and Eve (Genesis 1:29), but after the fall, humans became enemies of God. Even so, God has always shown His love and care through meals. For example, He provided food for Noah after the flood (Genesis 9:3) and gave the Israelites manna during their iourney to the Promised Land (Exodus 16:1–35). He also established the Passover as a covenant meal to remind the Israelites of their salvation from Egypt (Exodus 12) and invited the elders of Israel to eat with Him on Mount Sinai (Exodus 24:9-11).

The Lord's Supper is part of this biblical occurrences of meals symbolizing God's covenant with His people. In the New Testament, Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper during Passover (Matthew 26:17–30; Luke 22:7–20), calling it the new covenant in His blood (Luke 22:20). This meal reminds Christians of His sacrifice and their reconciliation with God. It also points forward to the heavenly banquet. the wedding supper of the Lamb, where believers will celebrate with Jesus forever (Revelation 19:9: 1 Corinthians 11:26).

The Scriptures encourage regular participation in the Lord's Supper (Acts 2:42; 1 Corinthians 11:17-34) to remember Christ's love, confess sins, and strengthen unity among believers. Beyond this, the church's mission is to spread the gospel and make disciples (Matthew 28:19–20). Ministries such as worship, teaching. fellowship, and service flow from this mission. These include helping those in need, preaching God's Word, and encouraging believers to grow in their faith (Romans 12:1 -2; James 1:27). The Lord's Supper is a key part of this work, reminding Christians of Jesus' sacrifice, their calling as His people, and the hope of eternal life with Him.

But you said, 'We will not walk in it.'

When we feel overloaded, the world can seem colder and harder. Even if the sun is shining, we might not notice because we're looking down. Birds may be singing, but all we can hear is our own cries of pain, sadness, and exhaustion.

When we feel this way, we might pull away from others and focus only on our problems. Sometimes we feel this way because of disappointment, sudden troubles or losses, or just too many responsibilities. Other times, it might be sin that weighs us down. No matter the reason, it can feel like a heavy burden pressing on us.

But in our sadness, God Almighty invites us to come close to Him and find rest. The prophet Jeremiah shared God's message, saying to look for the "good way and walk in it," which is how we'll find rest (Jeremiah 6:16).

Right now, why not look up to your Heavenly Father? Jesus offers us living water, which gives us strength. Take time to let your soul feel this strength so you can ask God to show you the right path. With the Holy Spirit's help, take one step, then another, and He will give you peace.

Jeremiah 6:16 also tells us the Israelites' response—they chose not to walk with God. Let's choose differently by standing, asking, and walking in God's way so we can find the rest Jesus promises.
