





Now Is the Time to Obey

In James 4:14, it says, "You do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away." This reminds us that life is short, and we can't predict the future. In the Bible, we learn that procrastination—delaying things—has been a problem for a long time (Proverbs 3:27–28; Isaiah 56:12). But the Bible tells us that *now* is the time to act: "Now is the accepted time; now is the day of salvation" (2 Corinthians 6:2). We shouldn't wait to obey God; today is the only moment we can be sure of.

James also teaches us that with knowledge comes responsibility. It's one thing to sin without knowing, but it's much worse to ignore what we know is right. Jesus and the apostle Peter also taught that we are held accountable for what we know but don't do (Luke 12:47–48; 2 Peter 2:21). This means that not doing what we should—sins of omission—are just as serious as doing wrong things. Leaving God out of our plans, when we know we should include Him, is a sin. Now is the time to obey God.
