What Makes Injustice Wrong? Jeremiah 9:24

"The only thing anyone should boast about is that they know Me and understand that I am the LORD, who shows unfailing love and who brings justice and righteousness to the earth, and that I delight in these things" (Jeremiah 9:24).

In our world, people suffer from unfair treatment. Some countries struggle with starvation, children are abused, people are forced into slavery, criminals go unpunished, and warlords hurt innocent people. But how do we know these things are wrong? What makes something unjust?

To understand injustice, we need a true sense of right and wrong. Without a standard of rightness, we can't really define justice.

The Bible often mentions both the LORD's justice and righteousness together. "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne" (Psalm 89:14). "The LORD gives righteousness and justice to all who are treated unfairly" (Psalm 103:6). God shows His people "righteousness and justice, unfailing love and compassion" (Hosea 2:19).

The LORD's righteousness defines what is truly right and wrong. Injustice goes against His nature. The LORD's heart cries out against starvation, abuse, slavery, and harm to the innocent. We know something is unjust by comparing it to the perfect justice and love of God.
