The Father of the two sons

The story of the prodigal son highlights two types of failure—one seen in the younger brother, who sinned openly, and the other in the older brother, who obeyed outwardly but lacked love in his heart. When the younger brother returned and was celebrated, the older brother felt upset and unfairly treated, saying, "I've always obeyed you, but you've never given me a celebration" (Luke 15:29).

The older brother's actions revealed he didn't act like a loving son but more like a worker trying to earn rewards. He felt superior to his younger brother, judging him for wasting his father's money (Luke 15:30). This attitude showed the older brother's heart was distant from both his father and brother. even though he followed the rules.

Jesus explained that both sinners and selfrighteous people fail in different ways. The sinners broke the rules to live as they wanted, while the self -righteous followed rules but lacked love for God and others. In the end, both groups missed what it meant to truly live as God's children.

The parable ends with the father's loving invitation, reminding the older brother that everything he had was already his (Luke 15:31-32). Jesus used this story to show that forgiveness is an act of grace, not something earned by following rules.



When we serve in everything we do, we bring honor to God. Jeremiah, one of God's prophets, showed us how to serve this way. Jeremiah is often called the "weeping prophet" because he felt so deeply for the people. He cared about their choices and wanted them to turn back to God. Jeremiah knew that if the people didn't change, they would face God's judgment.

Jeremiah bravely shared God's message with people who had "exchanged their glorious God for worthless idols," people who had "forsaken" Him (Jeremiah 2:11, 13). God's warning through Jeremiah was clear: "I am bringing disaster from the north, even terrible destruction" (Jeremiah 4:6).

In response, Jeremiah urged the people to "put on sackcloth, lament and wail, for the fierce anger of the Lord has not turned away from us" (Jeremiah 4:8). Jeremiah hoped they would repent and return to God.
